in accordance with the Regulation mentioned above:

- □ 1. for **data on infrastructure**, according to the Annex of the Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/670:
 - a. conforms to the requirements as stipulated in Article 4 (1-2) concerning the accessibility, exchange and re-use of data on infrastructure;
 - b. conforms to the requirements as stipulated in Article 4 (3) concerning the collaboration between data user and data holders to ensure signalling of data inaccuracies without delay;
 - c. conforms to the requirements as stipulated in Article 8 (1-3) concerning the updating of data on infrastructure.
- □ 2. for **data on real-time use of the network**, according to the Annex of the Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/670:
 - a. conforms to the requirements as stipulated in Article 7 (1-2) concerning the accessibility, exchange and re-use of data on the real-time use of the network;
 - b. conforms to the requirements as stipulated in Article 11 (1-2) concerning the updating of data on the real-time use of the network.
- 3. according to Article 1, makes this information available for:

 \Box all sections of the road network in **Austria**;

 \Box subsections of the road network in **Austria**, as described in the Annex of this self-declaration.

4. cooperates with the competent authority of the Member State for compliance assessment who will randomly check the correctness of the self-declaration as described in Article 12, related to the compliance with the requirements set out in Article 3 to 11. In the course of the compliance assessment, all data, records and relevant documents required for the execution must fully be made available free of charge and without restrictions.

- 6. in order to assess compliance with the requirements set out in Article 12, the following accompanying documents should be enclosed in support of this self-declaration and will be requested for random inspection:
 - a. a description of the data, digital map or real-time traffic information services they provide as well as the information on the quality thereof and the conditions of re-use of these data;
 - b. supplementing paragraph 3 of this self-declaration an overview of the road network for which respective data are provided.
